2022 BOND PROPOSAL FACTS

On May 3, 2022 our community will vote on a Holly Area Schools bond proposal. If approved, this bond proposal would provide \$97,000,000 for district-wide improvements, with **no tax rate increase** to property owners. This bond proposal was developed and prioritized as Phase 2 of the Master Plan for district facilities. Buildings, sites, and educational programs were assessed to determine and prioritize a list of facility needs throughout the district.

This bond proposal addresses the highest priority projects and focuses on three key areas.



- Supporting new learning environment standards
- Increasing classroom space to facilitate collaboration
- Creating multi-use spaces to support projectbased learning
- Establishing a career lab to enhance STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) and professional trades exploration
- Providing increased ventilation and natural daylight for learning environments
- Enhancing fine arts spaces and new athletic spaces



- Enhancing Academic, Professional Trades, Performing Arts, and Athletic opportunities
- Upgrading instructional technology
- Providing new STEM furnishings
- Constructing outdoor classrooms
- Building new construction trades center at the High School
- Replacing theater stage floor, lighting, and carpet
- Creating new marching band practice field
- Constructing new tennis complex
- Replacing track surface and establishing a new turf athletic field

- Addressing Phase 2 facility improvements in Master Plan
- Replacing worn playground structures
- Replacing septic systems at Davisburg and Rose Pioneer Elementary Buildings
- Upgrading fire protection, PA, sound and clock systems
- Replacing worn interior finishes and cafeteria furnishings
- Improving parking lots / sidewalks at the High School
- Providing new civic and community recreation opportunities and relocating District functions to the Sherman campus
