School Hours & Attendance

The Infant/Toddler Instructional Program is open 6:00 AM - 6:00 PM. We do not provide drop-in services. Families should identify a consistent and reliable attendance schedule.

Procare Billing System(Credit/Debit/ACH): All tuition is prepaid on the 1st of the month. Cash and Checks are not accepted.

Sibling discount: Discounts are available for families with more than one child enrolled in the Infant/Toddler Instructional Program and/or the tuition based preschool programs. Siblings are considered children living in the same household, related by blood, marriage/domestic partnership, adoption or foster care. 2 children: 10%, 3 children: 15%, 4 or more children: 20%
